
Parent IMPACT: Strategies for Coaching Your New Driver

Supervising Your Beginning Driver

The graphs to the right show a significant drop in the crash rate once a new driver has driven for 12 months or 1000-1500 miles of independent driving. Speaking from 40 years of in-vehicle driver education instruction experience, I feel that this is a good representation of why it is advisable for a parent to continue to closely monitor a beginning driver's skills and attitude even though it's not required by law after your teen gets a license. You can make a difference in your teen's life if you continue to monitor during this time.
